Event Details:

Memory Relay is an exciting observation and memory-based challenge designed to test participants' attention to detail, recall ability, communication skills, and teamwork. The activity combines individual performance with collaborative problem-solving, creating a fun and competitive environment where participants must observe, remember, communicate, and recreate information accurately under time constraints.

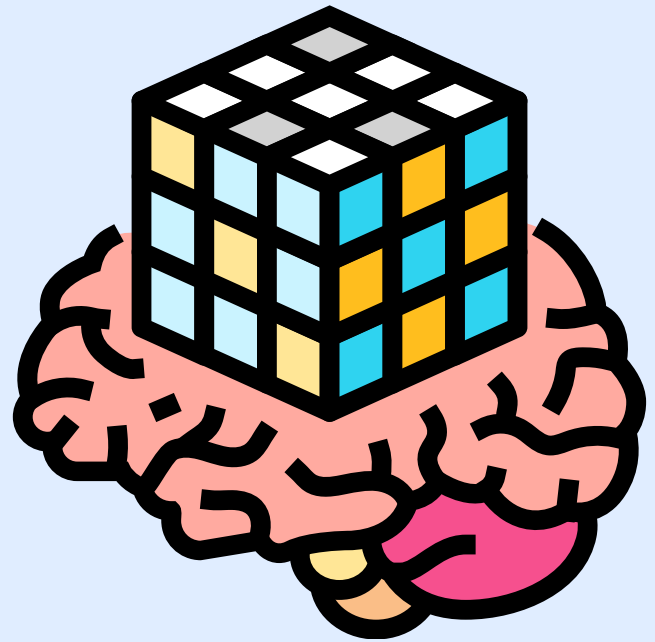
The event encourages participants to sharpen their focus, improve information retention, and experience the importance of effective communication while engaging in a highly interactive challenge.

Round Overview:

Round 1 – Memory Master

Participants will take part in a Kahoot-based memory quiz. An image will be displayed on the screen for a limited time, after which participants will answer questions based on the details they observed. Questions may focus on objects, colours, text, placements, characters, and other visual elements.

The top-performing participants will qualify for the next round.



Round 2 – Design Telephone

Qualified participants will be divided into teams of four members. One participant from each team will view a visual design for a limited duration and verbally describe it to the next teammate. The information will continue through the communication chain until the final participant recreates the design based solely on the descriptions received.

The recreated designs will be compared with the original, testing observation, communication, listening skills, and teamwork while producing fun and often surprising outcomes.

Rules:

1. Round 1 will be conducted individually.
2. Only qualified participants will advance to Round 2.
3. Teams in Round 2 must consist of 4 members each.
4. Use of mobile phones or any external assistance is strictly prohibited.
5. Only the designated participant may view the original design.
6. Communication between team members must be verbal only.
7. Participants must complete all tasks within the allotted time.
8. Any form of unfair practice may result in disqualification.
9. The decision of the organizing committee shall be final and binding.
