Event Details:

The Workplace Theatre is an interactive skit-based activity that promotes awareness of workplace ethics, professional conduct, and the principles of the Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act through creative storytelling and role-play.

Participants will analyse workplace situations and present them through short theatrical performances.

The activity encourages critical thinking, teamwork, and problem-solving while demonstrating how workplace issues can be addressed in a respectful and professional manner.

By combining creativity with real-life workplace scenarios, the event aims to create awareness while making learning engaging, interactive, and impactful.

Round Overview:

Single Round – Situation to Stage

Each team will receive a workplace-based scenario through a random draw. Teams will be given preparation time to understand the situation, develop a storyline, assign roles, and prepare a skit.

Teams will then perform a short theatrical presentation portraying the assigned situation and demonstrating an appropriate response or resolution. Creativity, acting, dialogues, expressions, and storytelling may be used to effectively communicate the message.



Rules:

1. Each team must consist of 4 participants.
2. Scenarios will be allotted through a random draw.
3. Teams must perform only the scenario assigned to them.
4. Preparation time and performance time limits must be strictly followed.
5. Each skit should clearly portray both the situation and its resolution.
6. Content must remain respectful, appropriate, and relevant to the theme.
7. Offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate content will lead to disqualification.
8. The decision of the organizing committee shall be final and binding.
